What's New? – Youth Protection Training

- The need for Youth Protection Training has never been greater!
 - Youth Protection Training protects our youth
 - Youth Protection Training protects YOU!
- Youth Protection Training is NOW required in order to be considered trained.
- You must recertify every two years.
 - You may take this course online
 - You may take the Youth Protection Quiz every two years to recertify or retake the course.

What courses do I need to take in order to be considered trained?

- Position Specific Training
- Youth Protection Training
- This is Scouting (New Leader Essentials will get you credit for this course, but you have to let us know the training date)

How does Position Specific Training Work?

- You receive training tailored to the position you hold today.
- If you change positions from Tiger Den Leader to Cub Scout Den Leader, or Cub Scout Den Leader to Webelos Den Leader, you need to take the training course for that position.

This is Scouting

- You only need to take this course once
- You may take this course online
- If you took New Leader Essentials, the records have not been updating, and you may be asked to give the date of training. This course is often offered in conjunction with Position Specific Training.
